In 1968 ARROW Inc., (a former arm of the National Congress of American Indians) undertook a project to improve tribal courts and formed the American Indian Tribal Court Judges Association. Fifty years ago this week, that same group of tribal court judges organized its own non-profit, now known as the National American Indian Court Judges Association. At that time, NAICJA adopted an arrowhead with the scales of justice as its symbol and logo. Today, after several manifestations, we introduce a contemporary logo that reflects not only the original symbolism and ties to our origins, but also serves as a beacon that continues to inspire us to serve and enhance tribal justice systems.
